General Description

Keep your chemical metering pump in its place with the new EZ Drum Shelf from Siemens Water Technologies.

The EZ Drum Shelf is designed to secure a metering pump atop a metal or plastic 55-gallon drum. The unit, constructed of 1/2 inch PVC, prevents pumps from tipping over. The semi-circular shelf has lift handles on each side, allowing the operator to quickly and safely move the pump and tubing assembly to a new drum.

The EZ Drum Shelf is a perfect complement to drum safety wands for 55-gallon metal drums with 2" NPT bung fittings, or for plastic drums with 2" buttress threads). The drum safety wand helps prevent curling of suction tubing, keeps the foot valve at the bottom of the tank and protects the operator from swinging tubing.

The easy-to-install and rugged design of the EZ Drum Shelf is ideal for industrial environments. The portable design allows easy transportation from drum to drum and will accept a variety of pump designs.

Optional accessories include a drum safety wand, flooded suction adapter, flow monitor, calibration cylinder and remote alarm box.

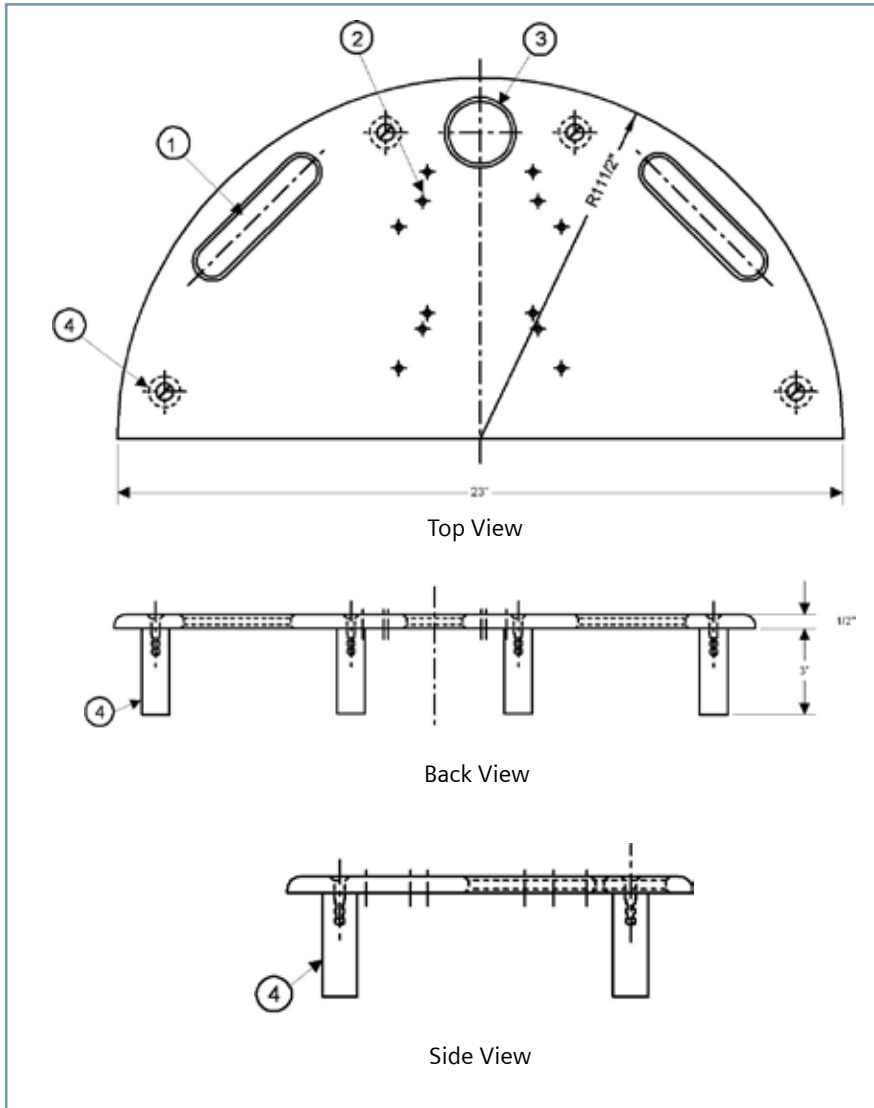
